Go mbeannai Dia duit (May God Bless You) in Gaelic, Happy March, Happy St. Patrick's Day and Welcome Spring.

St. Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland. He was a Christian missionary given credit with converting Ireland to Christianity around AD400. He used the shamrock as a symbol to explain the Trinity, God is One God in Three Persons, the shamrock is both one leaf and three and so it is with God, God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Ghost.

Ernest Holmes stated, "That throughout the ages, this Trinity has been taught. Every great religion and every great spiritual philosophy has taught this Trinity. Father, Son, and Holy Ghost is the Christian Trinity. It is the Thing, the Way It Works, and What It Does. The Thing is Absolute Intelligence; the way It works, is Absolute Law; and What It does, is the result—manifestation." And like God, made in It's image and likeness, we too are triune in nature, we think a thought, it drops into the Law, or Soul, which take the impress of that thought and produces out into our physical world.

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What did Ernest Holmes teach?

Ernest has been called a genius, a philosopher, a lecturer, a writer, a practitioner, a great teacher, a melder of religious and scientific principles in an understanding way, a gentle man and by his Mother, a question mark. Also, he had a great sense of humor. And with all of that he loved his family, gardening and cooking.

He studied all the great religions and philosophies and brought them together in the Science of Mind. And a church called Religious Science. Because of his in-depth study he not only knew the Principle and the Presence, but understood how it manifested in the individual and this he wanted to share with all who wanted to know. The Presence being the Love and the Principle being the Law.

He said, "God in man, as man, is man". Through all of his teachings this was important—that the student understood that they were God expressing to the very depth and breadth of their being.

There is not God and me—there is only God as me. That there wasn't a God to pray to, but rather an understanding that it is the individual consciousness that is cleared of any beliefs that are contrary to the outcome desired and brought to an acceptance of Truth. This he called Spiritual Mind Treatment.

Ernest prayed in silence as he was so clear that he was able to focus on the Presence in the quiet of his own mind. However, he knew this was not possible for many people, so he said no matter how you pray, in silence or in audible words, just do it and expect wonderful results.

In a talk he gave in 1958 in Whittier, California, while speaking, he pauses and comes to a place where he believes he has seen "the veil, and it is very thin." That is the veil between the Real and the unreal. He called it his "cosmic experience".

Each year he would speak at the conference at Asilomar in the Chapel by the Sea. His last address in 1959 contains the

exact words, "open at the top," as he didn't want his message of the day to become the be-all, know-all bible of tomorrow. He always wanted the philosophy to grow as new understandings and revelations were revealed to the individual. He taught, "The truth is true wherever you find it. Remember, sugar is sweet whether you find it in a sugar bowl or a dust pan."

There is so much to say about the Man and his teachings. So much that this short example is just that. It is up to the individual to search their own souls for what is True for them. To be quiet and let the Presence speak what is wanting to be discovered, experienced and believed.

The Truth is the Truth, but how we *know It* is an individual experience. We can all study the same books and we all walk away with different beliefs, ways to use It and experiences. The main thing is to Listen to YOUR SILENT VOICE and then experience the process of discovery and growth. Enjoy!
