

## Is Time Real?

Time, what is time? I had a professor in ministerial school who tried to convince us that time was not a real thing. He said, how many times have you just known you would be late, as it didn't seem possible that the time you had to get somewhere was far shorter than the time you thought it would take. 30 miles away and you only had 20 minutes—and you arrived on time and safe. I am sure you have examples when your idea of the time necessary to complete whatever task took far less time than expected.

Our sense of time often limits what we can accomplish. We put off or labor over a new idea or project because we have our sights on the time it would take and we become overwhelmed. Maybe I am only talking to myself—however...

For me, I have tried to prove to myself that my profes-

sor was right. I push the envelope by allowing less time than I really think it will take to do a task. Then I allow myself to just reflect calmly that time has no meaning and I will complete whatever it is that I have to do with time to spare. I also say to myself, "Something Greater than I am is in charge. And the task is completed easily, peacefully and effectively." This usually works and sometimes I have to keep reminding myself, "It works if I just let go".

I have learned that sometimes procrastination is a good thing. It seems that when I have put off a task, I found in the end it paid off. The extra time brought about the realization that had I done the task when I thought I should, the results wouldn't have been anywhere as good as they turned out. Sometimes procrastination to not doing it at all saved a great deal of grief. Had I have done the task, it would have been

dreadful. What I or another thought was necessary, really wouldn't have been good at all. Life is funny. We beat up on ourselves for the strangest reasons.

Procrastination is the avoidance of doing a task which needs to be accomplished. It is the practice of doing more pleasurable things in place of less pleasurable ones, or carrying out less urgent tasks instead of more urgent ones, thus putting off impending tasks to a later time. And I say, "What is wrong with that?" You never know what will happen or what could happen in the waiting. The problem is that in the waiting we beat up on ourselves. So in the time of waiting, go back to knowing that Something Greater is in charge and the task will be completed when the time is right.
